- One artwork from a middle school student will be featured on HELMEPA's new reusable tote bag, along with the artist's full name.



COMPETITION DURATION & SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES

Participants must submit their entries both <u>electronically</u> and in <u>physical</u> form by **Monday, March 31, 2025**:

- <u>Electronic submission:</u> A scanned version of the artwork, along with the appropriate declaration form (for participants under or over 18), must be uploaded <u>here</u>.
- <u>Physical submission:</u> The original artwork must be sent to HELMEPA's offices at the following address: HELMEPA, 7 Ymittou Street, 17564 Palaio Faliro – Athens, Greece, with a postmark no later than 31/03/2025.

ELIGIBILITY & TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

To be eligible, entries must meet the following requirements:

- Must be submitted by middle or high school students.
- May include painting, photography, collage, slogans, or any medium that supports HELMEPA's mission to protect the seas.
- Must be individual entries (one entry per participant).
- Must be in horizontal A3 format (42x29.7 cm).
- Scanned file: PDF or JPEG format with 300 DPI resolution and high quality.
- Must be accompanied by the appropriate declaration form:
 - a) For participants under 18: completed by a parent/guardian.
 - b) For participants over 18: completed by the student.

Entries that violate third-party rights or contain any illegal, offensive, or defamatory content will not be accepted. HELMEPA's Secretariat reserves the right to reject entries that are off-topic, incomplete, or contain inappropriate material.

BE INSPIRED BY THE SEA

The sea is full of fascinating, delicate, and colorful creatures and plants—many of which remain unknown but must be protected. It is a source of life, freshness, health, rejuvenation, playfulness, joy, relaxation, and holds many hidden mysteries. By diving into the sea's depths, we can discover a world filled with colors, aromas, tranquility, adventure, and diverse patterns and textures.

We invite you to explore the sea and create your own artwork with an **optimistic** message that showcases your love for it—whether through an expression of emotion, depiction of marine life, or an explosion of colors and patterns.



The following facts about the oceans and provided links may be helpful to you:

- Oceans cover three-quarters of the Earth's surface.
- Every other breath we take is thanks to the oceans.
- They provide us with food and drinking water.
- 50-80% of all life on Earth resides beneath the ocean's surface.
- Oceans absorb 25% of all CO2 emissions we produce.
- They regulate the planet's climate through ocean currents.
- They act as marine highways that support 90% of global trade.
