The four (4) TMSA Stages are analyzed, the various tools for a Shipping Company's progress are explained, such as Key Performance Indicators and Best Practices and a brief layout of the current structure of TMSA 3 Elements 1 to 13 is offered. Finally, the NEW (soon to be added) Element 14 "Managing the human element" is included, along with techniques such as behavioral competency assessment and human factors' approach.
